(This restriction does not apply to students who are on course to graduate and will be pursuing their next degree; however, they must still be a lecturer from any countries in new southbound countries). Previously studied in Taiwan for a degree at the same level. Are exchange students or dual-degree students through a partnership agreement with an institution overseas. Has already received stipends through this program for more than three years. Have been awarded by foreign governmental institutions or scholarship from a Taiwan (R.O.C.) government agency to support their studies in Taiwan.
