Datuk Sim Mow Yu - UTAR Scholarship

This Scholarship Fund was set up based on the funds donated by the Malaysian Chinese Association and in honour of the late Datuk Sim Mow Yu for his contributions to education in Malaysia. The purpose of the Scholarship Fund is to provide scholarships for undergraduates in Chinese Studies.

Minimum Criteria for the Scholarship

- STPM/ A-Levels or equivalent: 4As, or
- UEC or equivalent: 9As or
- Canadian Pre-University : 95% for all subjects with a minimum of 6 subjects, or
- South Australian Matriculation: As for all subjects with a minimum of 5 subjects, or
- UTAR Foundation Programmes: CGPA of 3.8000 and above
- Kolej Universiti Tunku Abdul Rahman Diploma or equivalent:
- CGPA of 3.8000 and above

Mr Ng Chin Kiat S.M.J. Scholarship

The scholarship is named after Professor Dr. Jenny Parameshvara Deva @ nee Ng Gek Pheng's late father who was among the initial team of Johor Bahru Chinese Prominent Business Persons at the time of the Foundation of Foon Yew Chinese School in 1913. The scholarship aims to:

- encourage Chinese students in Chinese medium schools to study Medicine and Bachelor of Surgery (MBBS) at UTAR.
- award the best admission results for newly registered students under the MBBS programme.

Eligibility Criteria

- Citizen of Malaysia
- Students from Foon Yew High School in Johor Bahru and Kulai campuses who are newly registered students in UTAR MBBS programme
- Best results submitted for admission. In case of a tie, the UTAR Scholarship and Loans Committee will then refer to the secondary school extra-curricular activities to justify eligibility
- Minimum 8As in UEC result
- Students from family with a total monthly income of RM10,000 and below will be given preference
